Based on production needs, the Costume Shop Manager will establish a plan realize the costume design creatively and collaboratively ensuring all costumes, crafts, soft goods and wigs are completed in a timely and fiscally responsible fashion.

- When applicable, train volunteers to provide assistance in the costume shop.
